To Halton Regional Government and the Town of  
Oakville,

There has been rushed action to build a new  
sewage treatment plant in Oakville without public  
input on:

- 1) Who should pay for it: the developers who will  
mostly benefit from it or the present homeowners
- 2) The technology to be used: ie will it adequately  
remove pollutants which favour algae growth in  
the lake?
- 3) How will it affect the residents and businesses  
located in proximity to the proposed location of  
this plant?

Since none of these questions (and several  
others) have been addressed in a meaningful manner,  
it is incumbent on the municipal and regional  
governments to extend the period allocated for public  
input on the matter. Failure to do so would clearly  
indicate a lack of concern for the democratic  
process,  
a key factor of which is public participation.
