

Dear Mr. Ohashi,

In view of the public concerns about the expansion of the Mid-Halton sewage plant, we urge you to delay implementation of this project until the public has received answers to its queries. Specifically, questions have been raised as to who is paying for the increased sewage created by growth and development, how the contents of the plant will be disposed of, the proximity of the plant to a residential area, the increase in truck traffic that an expanded plant will create, and the impact an expanded plant will have on Oakville environmental and health issues.

Sufficient public comment on the effects of this project has not yet been achieved. Please extend the comment period and widely publish the answers to the above concerns.
